## **Job Posting Details**

The Division of Humanities of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) invites applications for a tenure-track position at the level of Assistant Professor in **Anthropology**. The position is for a cultural anthropologist with a background in health and/or medical issues. While the geographical area is open, it should complement the regional strengths of the Division of Humanities and the University. The position will strengthen the new emphasis of Anthropology in the Division on cultural anthropology at the intersection of health and medicine.

Applicants should either have or will receive a PhD degree in Anthropology by August 2024 from a reputable university. The successful candidate should demonstrate a strong commitment to excellence in research and teaching and show promise for publications with international impact. Prior publications in cultural anthropology in areas relating to health and medicine, especially in leading journals, will be highly valued.
